# CLASS OF 2026 COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE STATISTICS

In the 2021-2022 admissions cycle, Lumiere alumni were accepted to undergraduate degrees at every single Ivy League university, Stanford, UC Berkeley, Oxford and Cambridge. This includes

To understand this better, we sent out a survey to more than 150 alumni that applied to universities this year. The responses show that 9.8% of Lumiere alumni who applied to an Ivy League university or Stanford got in – that is 115% higher than the general rate of acceptance at these universities!

This is how students who applied to university this year positioned their Lumiere project in their college application process:

- 85% mentioned it in the "Activities" section of their application
- 52% wrote about it in either a main or supplemental essay
- 40% —— of them included either a recommendation letter or an evaluation form from their mentor



This comes with a commitment to diversity and financial inclusion.



Lumiere alumni who applied to universities this year represent citizens of **21 different countries** 



Students that did the Lumiere Research Scholar Program through the help of our **financial aid program** got into Princeton, Dartmouth and the University of Pennsylvania (with significant financial aid offers).



Lumiere alumni received scholarships worth more than an estimated **1** million USD such as the Trustee Scholarship at the University of Southern California (full ride), full scholarships to the University of Toronto, the Zollman Scholarship at Smith College (college's highest scholarship) and the Presidential Scholarship at Bryn Mawr College.


